



## FPSC 2022/23 Fuel Subsidy

**What** Funding for up to one vehicle per region (e.g., Calgary and surrounds, Kimberley and surrounds, etc.) containing a minimum of 2 coaches traveling greater than 100 km (one way) from a coach's primary city/town of residence to Panorama for regular weekend on-snow programming.

**Why:** FPSC does not have a large enough pool of local (i.e. residing in Invermere / Panorama) coaches to service the membership of the club. Off-setting the cost of fuel can reduce economic barriers for coaches traveling to Panorama from surrounding regions. The intent is *not* for drivers to profit from the subsidy, rather to solely cover the cost of fuel.

**When:** Fuel subsidies will be paid upon submission of an invoice. Invoices must be submitted within one (1) month of travel and will be paid within two weeks of submission. This subsidy is valid for the 2022/23 FPSC regular ski season only.

**Who:** Coaches contracted by FPSC for the 2022/23 Season (i.e., this subsidy is not available to parents / friends / etc. who may be transporting coaches). Two vehicles per week will be approved for the fuel subsidy during the regular season.

**How:** Coaches must request the subsidy prior to travel. Requests must be submitted via email to both [headcoach@freestylepanorama.com](mailto:headcoach@freestylepanorama.com) and [admin@freestylepanorama.com](mailto:admin@freestylepanorama.com) **before** travel occurs.

### Details:

- The amount to be reimbursed will be \$100 per round trip for coaches traveling from Calgary and \$55 per round trip for coaches traveling from Kimberley). Reimbursement for travel originating in other regions will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis. Reimbursement amounts are based on the Canada Energy Regulator website (<https://www.cer-rec.gc.ca/en>) quoted average mileage of 9 L/100 km for vehicles in Canada and an average fuel price of \$2/L.
- FPSC supports a maximum of one vehicle per weekend per region for round-trip travel between a coach's primary city/town of residence and Invermere/Panorama.
- Vehicles must contain a minimum of 2 occupants who are scheduled to coach for FPSC. Passenger space must be made available by the driver to any member of the FPSC Coaching team to receive this funding as the intent is to serve all coaches.
- Vehicle owner/driver must contact Head Coach and/or Club Administrator one week prior to departure for pre-approval of expense. Funding will be issued to a maximum of one vehicle per region per week. Funding priority will be given to vehicles carrying the largest number of coaches.
